The basis for acceptance into membership has two fundamental elements, which we would ask you to consider:

(1) Acceptance into membership is primarily on the basis of personal faith in Jesus Christ. You will be asked by two interviewing Deacons to explain in simple terms how you came to faith (in other words how, and when you became a Christian) and how you have seen God working in your life since then.

(2) We have a Statement of Faith, which outlines our basis of belief and a Constitution which describes the form of Church government to which we adhere. Please study it carefully and indicate your agreement to it, or, if you have any questions, raise them at the Membership Classes or at your interview.
